PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Acclaim[®] Extra is a selective postemergence herbicide that controls crabgrass, goosegrass, and other annual and perennial grasses in turf. Acclaim Extra is a systemic herbicide that may work in a single treatment. It is one of the only postemergence herbicides that can control crabgrass effectively with good tolerance on desirable turf. Acclaim Extra controls a wide range of crabgrass growth stages, from spikes to 5-tillers.

MODE OF ACTION/ HOW PRODUCT WORKS

Acclaim Extra is a systemic herbicide and is absorbed primarily through the foliage. It is most effective during periods of active weed growth and adequate soil moisture. It is rainfast approximately one hour after drying on the leaf.

After application, susceptible grassy weeds stop growing and lose their competitiveness. Visual symptoms are expressed as chlorosis (yellowing) of the leaves at approximately 4 to 10 days after application. Within 12 to 21 days, the leaves turn red or purple, resulting in the subsequent death of the plant.

EFFECTIVE TANK-MIX OPTION

Acclaim Extra can be tank mixed with preemergence herbicides to provide a single pre or postemergence treatment for season-long annual grass control. It can be tank mixed with most other turf management products, including fungicides, insecticides and other herbicides.

Preemergence Residual Herbicides

A tank-mix application of Acclaim Extra Herbicide and residual herbicides can provide residual annual grass control. Acclaim Extra can be tank mixed with the following products: Barricade[®] 65DG, bensulide 4E, Dacthal[®] W75, Dimension[®], pendimethalin 60DG, and Tupersan[®] 50W.
